Dear Parents and Carers,

Could you be our next Parent Governor?

We currently have an opportunity for a parent or carer to join our Governing Body as a Parent Governor.

We have recently welcomed a new Parent Governor to the Governing Body and would now love to welcome another member of our parent and carer community to the team.

Being a governor is a rewarding opportunity to become more involved in the wider life of the school and to play a part in helping shape its future. Our governors work alongside the Headteacher and senior leaders, providing support and constructive challenge and helping us ensure that the school continues to develop and provide the very best opportunities for our pupils.

What does being a governor involve?

Our Full Governing Body meets once each term. Meetings are held in person at school, with the option to join via Microsoft Teams if you are unable to attend in person.

Beyond the formal meetings, there are opportunities for governors to:

- visit the school and see our work in action;
- work alongside members of the senior leadership team;
- develop a greater understanding of different areas of the school;
- contribute to discussions about our priorities and strategic direction;
- help monitor the progress we are making against our plans; and
- bring their own skills, experience and perspective to the Governing Body.

The role is strategic. Governors are not involved in the day-to-day running of the school, but they play an important part in helping us consider where we are, where we want to go and how well we are getting there.

Do I need experience?

No previous experience of governance or education is necessary.

We are looking for someone who cares about our school and its pupils, is interested in its future and is willing to contribute their own experience and perspective.

Parents and carers have skills and experiences from all sorts of backgrounds that can be incredibly valuable to a Governing Body. You do not need to be an expert, and training and support will be available to help you develop in the role.

You would also be joining an established Governing Body and working alongside our recently appointed Parent Governor.

Please don't let uncertainty about the role stop you from getting in touch.

If you think you might be interested, or you are simply curious and would like to find out more, I would be very happy to have an informal conversation with you before you decide whether you would like to put yourself forward.
